WHERE: City Hall Bridge Galley, 200 North Spring Street, Los Angeles, CA, 90012

WHAT: Art competitions will be presented during the annual celebration of "Deaf Awareness Month 2009; Students may enter only one work of art.

PRIZES:

• Prizes in each age group will be awarded in the following three categories: Painting, Drawing, and other Art Forms.

ART COMPETITION:

- Artwork will be displayed at the City Hall Bridge Gallery September 23 - October 23, 2009.
- Judges to look at art pieces on September 24, 2009.
- There will be two award presentations:
 - Each winning student will be recognized in front of the Los Angeles City Council on Friday, September 25th in recognition of "Deaf Awareness Month."
 - Award presentation on Saturday, September 26th at 2:00 p.m. under the main stage at DEAFestival in Woodley Park in Van Nuys, CA.

REQUIREMENTS FOR ENTRY:

- Students must be daytime students under the age of 19
- Only one entry per student is allowed.
- Pieces must be framed under with wire suitable for hanging on the wall. Freestanding art such as sculpture or ceramics cannot be accepted. Art must be no larger than 20 x 15 inches and ready for hanging in the gallery within the following categories:
 - Painting (watercolors, acrylics, oil, tempura)
 - Drawing (black & white, color)
 - Other (computer art, crafts, stained glass, etched glass, fabric. Check for suitability)
- Name, address and phone number must be attached to the back of each art piece.

The DEAFestival is a family event. Images should be suitable for the general public. We reserve the right to remove objectionable images and structurally suspect framing.

A separate registration form must be filled out for the art competition. The form is included with this mailing. Feel free to make copies. The DEAFestival 2009 Art Competition form may be obtained by visiting website: www.lacity.org/council/cd6/.

Make sure all work meets the art competition requirements. Incomplete or illegible forms will disqualify the artwork from entry.
